He also worked as an Assistant Brew Master at the AB Brewery in St. Louis. Currently he consults with all major Brewers in US and Canada, Regionals, and Craft Brewers as well as consults for Imerys (World Minerals) Cynergy Implementation. His areas of expertise include brewing process design and development, optimization for quality, Brewing vessel steam control, lautering/milling optimization for yield, wort recovery, and filtration and chill proofing strategies.
