District President, Duties and responsibilities

The District President is the presiding Officer of the District Executive Board and is duly elected by the members of the District.

The President shall be the executive head of the District and shall preside over all meetings of the District which include the business meetings of the District held coincident to the regularly scheduled monthly technical dinner meetings, and meetings of the Officers and activity Chairs that make up the District Executive Board. Other special meetings may be called by the President with sufficient notice to the participants. The President, through the members of the District Executive Board, shall arrange the programs of all district meetings and shall direct the resolutions of the District Executive Board. The President shall commission all committees and task forces related to District activities. In addition, the President has the following duties:

- shall provide written report of his/her administration at biannual Association meetings.
- shall serve as first substitute should the District Governor not be able to attend the Association governance meetings.
- shall act in the best interests of the members of the District and the Association.
